How to measure your kitchen.

Kick off your kitchen journey by sending us a drawing of your space with measurements. This will really help when we start working together on a design for your new kitchen. We will be able to provide you with layout options and a detailed price. Here are some great tips for measuring and space planning.

Step 1

To begin, you will need

- paper
- tape Measure
- Pencil/Pen
- Draw a simple sketch your room as a box

Step 2

Make a note of any openings in your room – knowing where doors, windows and archways are will help us get your design just right. Tell us where any sewer pipes, hot water systems, electrical meters, gas meters, fuse boxes, air conditioning ducts are in case they impact on the space where kitchen cabinets and appliances will be going.

- Add doorways measurements
- Windows measurements
- Measure floor to ceiling height
- Location of existing plumbing/waste (if staying in same location)
- Location of existing oven, fridge & pantry (if staying in same location)
- Advise if you are keeping the existing flooring (to ensure same foot print)
- Label and reference walls, windows and items a,b,c,d etc

Step 3

Most people already have an idea of the kind of kitchen shape they want.


- Take a photo of your existing kitchen and send (if you can)
- Send images of kitchen ideas that you have seen on-line or magazines




